HOW TO PAINT



Use the paintbrush to paint your own design on the plaster.



Dry the plaster for 24 hours after you have finished painting.

DO'S

- Wear apron before you start painting.
- Think before you paint and draw.
- Use a newspaper to protect table before you start painting.
- Close the lid of color paint container after you use it.
- Wash the paintbrush before you paint the other color and wash thoroughly after use.

- You can add a few drops of water to the color if it looks too dry and sticky.
- 2. You can freely mix up colors to get a new color.
- To protect your colors, allow the plaster to dry for one day before using.










How to make a snow globe



Apply the Glue to the dome. Dry the dome for 24 to 48 hours after you have finished. TIPS: Try to use the rubber band to fix the dome.



Position your figurine. Apply your glue dot to the bottom of the figurine. Then, press the figurine down onto the dome base.



Use turkey baster to fill the double wall dome with water.

Using glitter 1-2 teaspoons into the water. But don't overdo it or your snow globe will look hazy.



Use the cap and base fixture to close and fix the dome.



Shake your snow globe gently and enjoy your lovely craft! Display it on a windowsill, bookshelf or anywhere else you'd like to show off your handiwork.

- Use bottled water for best results.
- Try not to put too much glitter because you won't be able to see your figure.
